

Dear Parents of AP Students:

Advanced Placement testing for 2025 will be held at the Bellevue Public Schools Welcome Center, located at 2600 Arboretum Drive next to the Lied Activity Center. School vans or buses will be available for any student needing transportation to and/or from the test center. Most tests will take 3 ½ - 4 hours to administer. *Please note that afternoon exams will end AFTER 3pm – the end of a normal school day. Students should plan for pick-up at the Welcome Center for tests that end after 3p.m. Buses will be available to bring students back to school from the World History and Computer Science Principles exams.*

1. **ALL STUDENTS** must complete the transportation form, WHETHER YOU PLAN TO RIDE THE BUS OR NOT, by April 22nd using this QR code.
2. **A permission slip is required for students driving themselves.** Permission slips are available in students' Schoology Instructional Roster or on the Bellevue West website and can be returned via email to donna.pearson@bpsne.net or brought to room 114.



Bus riders should gather in the South Gym Lobby 20 minutes before the scheduled start time for their exam. Students taking afternoon exams should eat during 1st lunch. Students taking more than one exam on the same day should bring a sack lunch with them to the test center. There will only be a short break between tests for lunch. **It is the student's responsibility to report to the test center on time** - latecomers may not be admitted.

Students will be excused from school blocks 1 & 2 (including Advisory on Wednesday) for morning exams, and blocks 3 & 4 (including lunch) for afternoon exams. Students taking morning exams will be allowed 30 minutes for lunch when they return to the building. A schedule of dates and times for each exam is printed on the back of this letter.

This year, all AP exams will be given at least partially digitally. **STUDENTS MUST BRING THEIR SCHOOL-ISSUED iPad, FULLY CHARGED, ALONG WITH A CHARGING BLOCK AND CORD.**

External keyboards will be provided, and students may bring a mouse. A graphing calculator is required for students taking the AP Calculus and/or AP Statistics exams. Scientific or graphing calculators are permitted on the Biology, Chemistry and Physics exams. **Students should leave their cell phones and other electronic devices at home.** This includes smart watches or any device that can access the internet. Devices that make noise during an exam may be grounds for dismissal.

The College Board website, collegeboard.org, contains helpful information to prepare your student for test day. Students can access daily practice videos through their AP classroom account, and a full-length practice test is provided in the Bluebook app.
